What is Pae Ora? Pae Ora (Healthy Futures) is the Government's vision for Māori health. It provides a platform for Māori to live with good health and wellbeing in an environment that supports a good quality of life. The Pae Ora bill provides for a new structure and new accountability arrangements for the publicly-funded health system, in order to protect, promote, and improve the health of all New Zealanders.

We know the barriers Māori whānau face when accessing primary healthcare, and the impacts of these barriers on increasing inequities. This webinar will explore how Pae Ora encourages everyone in the health and disability sector to work collaboratively to learn and think beyond narrow definitions of health, and to provide high-quality and effective services for whānau.
